TALK ABOUT IT

Read: Deuteronomy 5:33, Acts 2:42-47

For us to grow in our relationship with God we need to be obedient to Him. We also need to make sure we have the right tools, and are using them on a daily basis. We grow by reading the Bible, praying, talking with other believers, and so much more!

Talk About It:

- What are some ways you can learn more about God?
- How do you think obedience helps you grow?
- Do you have someone in your life you can ask your questions about God to? If so, who is it?



WAYS TO WORSHIP

Read: Revelation 3:20

Worship begins when we answer God's knock. But what does that mean? You answer His knocking through prayer. First, you must realize that you sin, and that sin separates you from having the kind of relationship with God that He created you to have. Then it is as simple as ABC. A, ADMIT your sin to God and ask Him to forgive you. Next: B, BELIEVE that Jesus is who the Bible says He is. And finally: C, CHOOSE to follow Jesus with your life. That means you spend your life, one day at a time, trying to obey and be more like Christ in all you say and do.



THINK ABOUT IT

Read: Acts 16:25-34

God gives each of us special gifts, abilities, and resources that He wants us to use to serve others, and to spread the truth of God's Word to the people around us. Let's take time now to think about what God gives us that we can share with others to show them God's love.

Think About It:

- How can you use your skills, gifts, and abilities to serve others and share the good news of Jesus with people?
