#### **TALK ABOUT IT**

Read: Matthew 28:1-8

- Why do you think the women were the first ones to find out that Jesus had risen from the grave?
- What did the angel tell the women to do?
- How do you think they felt when they saw the angel, and then the empty tomb?



### **WORSHIP**

Gather as a family and listen to *Death Was Arrested by North Point Worship*. Pay attention to the lyrics as you listen to - or sing them out - together. When the song is over, spend time worshiping through prayer, thanking God for what Jesus' death and resurrection means to you.



## **THINK ABOUT IT**

Read: John 20:24-29

- What did Thomas say he would have to see and do in order to believe Jesus had risen?
- What did Jesus do 8 days after Thomas said that?
- When Jesus said "blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed", who was He talking about?



## **EMPTY TOMB = GOOD NEWS**

You'll need a paper cup, markers, foil, tape, and a 24" string. Have your child color the paper cup to look like rock, dirt, and grass. Push one end of the string through the center of the foil leaving about 12" on both sides. Tape the string to the center of the foil and then wad the foil into a ball leaving the string extending out both sides. Poke a small hole in the bottom of your paper cup. Then thread one end of the string through the hole. Now when the cup is on it's side, the stone can be moved by the string into the cup to close the cave. Pull the other end of the string to "roll the stone away!" Your child can be even more creative and use a shoe box or other paper to make a background for your cave. Use your cave to share the amazing news that Jesus is ALIVE!



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
