Fourth Quarter Faith - 1/2/2021

OVERVIEW

As we begin a new year, God is inviting us to learn lessons from the difficulties of 2020; to examine those challenges and then allow Him to cultivate a fourth quarter faith in us. Where is God revealing that your faith in Him is weak and feeble? How can we all allow Him to change and strengthen us?

Scriptures (NIV): Hebrews 11:8-9, 35-38;12:1,12

APPLICATION

- Share something you are grateful for and that you did well in this past year.
- Share something you wish you would have done differently or done better last year.
- Jeremy talks about a fourth quarter faith and mentions several examples from Hebrews 11 (Abraham, Joseph, Moses, Rahab, Gideon). What stands out to you about the examples he highlights, or the other examples mentioned in this chapter?
- God often uses difficult situations to reveal where our faith is weak. How might God be using the challenges you've encountered in the past year to expose weakness in you? Share one area of weakness and how God opened your eyes to see it.

NEXT STEP: God is inviting us to cultivate a fourth quarter faith like those mentioned in Hebrews 11. Start by asking God to reveal where you are weak. Then each day this week, read through Hebrews 12. Filter your reading through the lens of asking God to expose weakness in you. Share with a friend what God is showing you.
