APPLICATION

- 1. Have you ever had a cross cultural experience where you saw poverty firsthand? Share your experience.
- 2. Woody and Nan began the service by telling their experience with Compassion and then Owen told about his experience. These are often called testimonies in the church. Why is a testimony or witness a powerful thing to hear? How did these stories affect you?
- 3. Woody and Owen both indicated that poverty, at its center, is spiritual. Do you agree with that statement? Why or why not?
- 4. We live in an area where the kind of poverty that Owen experienced is rare or non-existent. That doesn't mean, though, that there aren't needs around us. Acts 1:8 shows Jesus' priority for His followers... "you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." How could you be involved in continuing His mission?
