OVERVIEW

Jesus told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." How is God inviting you into His work?

Scriptures: Luke 10:2; 2 Timothy 3:16-17

APPLICATION

- REVIEW: Share something God revealed to you in the last week as you studied Luke 10.
- Looking at Luke 10:2, how would you answer these three questions?
 - a. What does this passage teach me about God (the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit)?
 - b. What does this passage teach me about disciples?
 - **c.** What does this mean to me? Think of something tangible and applicable that you can do this week.
- Luke 10:2 says, "Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into the harvest." Jeremy mentioned a "co-laborer list." As you think of the people you wrote down, how might God be asking you to engage with them?
- This week what is one practical step you are going to take toward your "co-laborers"?
- TAKE ACTION: You are a disciple-maker. This week be praying for God to move in those co-laborers you have chosen. One idea might be to invite them into studying Luke 10 daily and asking the three questions verse by verse.
