## OVERVIEW

As we look at how to become a church body that has a disciple-making culture, the foundation must be the Gospel. Without the Gospel we have nothing. ## APPLICATION

- Where in your life would you like to experience personal growth in 2022?
- In a few short sentences, how would you describe the Gospel (the good news)?
  - 1 Corinthians 15:1-6 explains that the Gospel is that Christ died for our sins, was buried and three days later was raised back to life and all of this was predicted in the Scriptures and affirmed by hundreds of witnesses.

• The foundation of the Christian faith is the Gospel. Our belief can be in vain if the way we live doesn't match the Gospel we hold on to. What area(s) in your life do not currently reflect the good news of the Gospel?

## NEXT STEPS

• Confession is the first step to making your life right with Jesus. Talk to God and confess areas where you are currently struggling, where you are holding onto control, and where you need His intervention.
