OVERVIEW

APPLICATION

- How does baptism symbolize the decision to follow Jesus?
- In what ways are you deciding to follow Jesus? What are some places in your life you haven't fully surrendered to Him?
- Have you ever been baptized? If so, what was that like? If not, why not?
- Throughout the morning, we were reminded that people come to Christ, but they rarely come alone. Often, people come to faith by being led by other people. Is there a role you need to take in someone's life to share Christ with them...or....do you need to accept someone else's influence? In other words, how can you be active in that equation—either leading or following someone to Christ?

HOMEWORK: This week, take the time to write down the names of people in your life who might need to be a part of the body of Christ. Start praying for their salvation.
