OVERVIEW

Through Paul's writing in Philemon we see that God's transforming power ushered in a new Kingdom – a radical new call to all people from different places to come together because of the gospel. We also have the opportunity to model something that looks very different from the chaos of the world today. Will the love and the power of the gospel in your life lead you to love others like Christ loves and live out this radical calling?

APPLICATION

- Share your feelings as you viewed the different pictures that were shown.
- Read through the book of Philemon. God's Word and lessons have no bounds for time. How can you apply what you read to your own life? What stood out to you?
